

Tour Douro Valley



Douro Valley - It is an area of northeastern Portugal with more than 26 thousand hectares, classified by UNESCO, on December 14, 2001, as a World Heritage Site, in the category of cultural landscape and surrounded by mountains that give it particular climatic and climatic characteristics.

This region, which is bathed by the Douro River and is part of the so-called Douro Vinhateiro, has been producing wine for more than 2000 years, among which is the world-famous Porto wine.

Its origins go back to the second half of the seventeenth century, when Port Wine began to be produced and exported in quantity, especially to England.

The long tradition of viticulture has produced a cultural landscape of exceptional beauty that reflects its technological, social and economic evolution.

- Pick up in your hotel
- Drive and stop for great views
- Tour and Tasting on the winery at Quinta Fonte do Milho (3 Wines, Olive oil tasting, tapenade, olives, local bread and jams)
- Lunch on a traditional Portuguese restaurant
- Tour and Tasting on the winery at Quinta da Pacheca (Wines and Port Wines)
- Drop off in your hotel

During the Harvest Season (September) you can add a Lagarada (Traditional Grape Treading) to the experience. (Add 40 Euros per person if you choose this experience)

- All tours can be changed as requested by the client
- More farms to visit can be added
- This tour is for a whole day but a tour but you can have for half a day with only one winery.
