

# Tour Évora



**Évora:** The region of Évora is an ancient territory, with traces of human occupation since prehistory.

The privileged geographical position may explain, in part, the importance that the city has acquired since antiquity, the political and social center of all the civilizations that have marked the current Portuguese territory. During the Roman period, Évora acquired the status of a municipality under Latin law and the honorific designation of Liberalism Julia. This period was characterized by a remarkable economic and artistic development, as evidenced by the monumental remains that have survived to the present day.

The Visigoth and Muslim domains remain largely obscure. The city maintained, however, its importance as a regional urban center. At the end of the Islamic period, the city was large and populous: it had two mosques, an intense commercial activity and a fertile term, with diversified agricultural production.

- Visit Cartuxa Winery or Fita Preta (Not included in the tour price, 30 euros per person for the visit and tasting or just by the glass)
- Return to Lisbon
