

Tour Aveiro, Valega and Cortegaça Church



Aveiro - The Portuguese Venice - Capital of the Ria, a vast lagoon basin where the sweet waters of the Vouga river mix with the waters of the sea, Aveiro, intersected by watery streets where colorful Moliceiro boats glide, is one of the most interesting cities on the Portuguese coast.

Valega: The exterior of the Mother Church of Santa Maria de Valega is covered with azulejos, traditional Portuguese ceramic tiles. What makes the Mother Church stand out is the unique arrangement of the tiles, which depict motifs from nature, saints, and biblical scenes. The tiles covering the church were laid in the 1960s and come from the Aleluia Factory based in Aveiro.

Cortegaça: The church was built between 1910 and 1918, although the oldest record of a church in this place is a testament from 1163. The exterior is decorated with monochromatic blue tile panels that represent various saints and biblical.
